Do you need help paying your rent?



The Eviction Moratorium is ending As of July 1, every renter in Oregon must pay their current rent or risk being evicted. If you want more time to pay your past due rent, you must provide a Declaration of Hardship to your landlord. If you do not, they are allowed to give you an eviction notice based on nonpayment of past due rent, beginning in July 2021.

If your household income is less than \$61,900 for a family of two, or \$77,350 for a family of four, and COVID 19 affected your income, you may be able to receive help paying past rent or utilities.
